The chief executive role. Barry is responsible for all the staff and reports directly to the Board of Directors. He has overall control of all the staff's work and is the office point of contact for all departments of The FA.

Football Development Administrator

Sarah is responsible for the administration of football development including coach education and development schemes. Sarah supports the development staff and as such works with them and clubs and leagues over Charter Standard, disability football, welfare and referee development as well as courses put on by Cornwall FA.
