



CONTINUOUS SERVICE AWARDS

Rationale

- To recognise the valuable service referees and all those involved in supporting referees perform in our national game
- To reward appropriately the continuous activity of our referees as well as those who support them
- The scheme should act as a retention tool as it will reward those individuals who have put so much into refereeing
- Continuous service is rewarded for whatever role you play in refereeing e.g. referee, assessor, instructor or mentor.
- Awards are for 25, 40 & 50 years continuous service
- 50 year Awards to receive a gold plated medal

How

- Recommendations are made by the County Football Association to their Regional Manager on the appropriate form
- All recommendations are then sent to the Head of National Referee Development for consideration and action
- A suitably framed certificate is then sent to the County Football Association for presentation
- The Head of National Referee Development to highlight special awards and the presentation to take place at significant events such as high profile FA Cup Matches, International games etc.
