



Process for accessing Designated Spectators' Area Barrier grants from the Football Foundation

1. The FA will communicate directly with youth leagues explaining the process and providing an application form the week commencing September 1st.
2. Leagues should apply to County FAs only on the application form provided. Please note that no payment is required from a League until it has received its Football Foundation vouchers and submitted its final order to Sponsor Bank.
3. County FAs will co-ordinate all the responses.
4. County FAs will forward one order form summarising all their league requirements to the Football Foundation. As The Football Foundation's 50% offer of support for the Barriers is time-limited to two application windows (November 1 and December 1 2008) Leagues are being advised to return their submissions to their CFA by October 6 or November 10 2008. This has been extended to 29th May 2009.
5. The Football Foundation (FF) will keep track of potential orders and update the Barrier suppliers (Sponsorbank) of the potential demand.
6. FF will supply leagues with the necessary vouchers and the relevant information on how they can order the Barriers from Sponsorbank
7. Leagues should send the voucher (which lasts for three months) and cheques or other payment methods to Sponsorbank for the total cost of their equipment.
8. Sponsorbank will distribute the equipment directly to the delivery addresses on the application form. The first batch of barriers will be distributed by the end of November. The second batch will be distributed by early January.

Cost Calculator

The Cost of the Barriers to Youth leagues is £76.37

With the generous support of the Football Foundation 50% of this cost is available to Youth Leagues delivering the Respect Programme. The final cost will vary slightly according to delivery charges. Deliveries to multiple addresses and individual deliveries are possible but will incur slightly different delivery costs. These are listed below;

1 - 10 barriers	10- 50 barriers	50 and over barriers
£ 46.41 each	£ 44.65 each	£ 42.89 each

For example if a League were to order 15 barriers to be delivered to one address and 4 barriers to be delivered individually this would incur the following costs -

$$15 \times £44.65 + 4 \times £ 46.41 = £855.39$$

Please return this form to the Respect Lead Officer at your County Football Association. The Football Foundation's 50% offer of support for the Barriers is time-limited to two application windows by November 1 and December 1 2008. After these dates it is likely that Leagues and Clubs will be required to pay the full cost of the barriers. It is therefore imperative that you return your League submission to your CFA by October 6 or November 10 2008.
