



### **Geoff Lee**

Geoff moved to the south west from Essex in 1970 to begin teacher training at St Lukes College, Exeter. He took up a teaching post at Callington Community College in 1974. He is still there today.

As a player, Geoff was a member of the Penzance team which won the South Western League in the 1974-75 season. He has also played for Bodmin, Truro, Saltash, and St Blazey and represented Cornwall FA from 1974-79.

On the touchline he was Team Manager for Cornwall County Youth FA during the late 70s as well as the Team Manager for Cornwall Schools Under 19 during the same time and in to the early 80s.

He continued to develop on the football administration side as a member of the CCFA Youth Committee in the 70s and as East Cornwall Schools FA Secretary from 1974 until 1990. It was at that point that Geoff joined the English Schools FA Council as representative for South West (Cornwall, Devon and Somerset).

His time there took him onto being Chairman of the English Schools FA from 1999 to 2000. During the same period, he chaired the Schools Football International Board. In 2005 Geoff was appointed a Life Member upon retirement from Council of the ESFA after completing 15 years as Council Member.

His involvement with Cornwall FA began again in 2002 when he was the co-opted member for schools on the County FA's Council. This was followed in 2005 with his appointment as Council Area Member for Division 2 (South East Cornwall).

In the same year, Geoff was appointed as the FA Representative from Cornwall. In this capacity, he currently serves on the Vase Committee, the Women's Committee, the Football Development Committee and on the Girls Centres of Excellence sub committee.
